

Faculty Scholars Award Application

All first year applicants for JD admission are eligible to apply for the Faculty Scholars Award. This award is based on merit without regard to financial need. Full tuition plus a \$7,000 stipend is awarded for the first year of law school. Each year thereafter, scholarship renewal is contingent upon maintaining a 2.8 grade point average at the close of each academic year.

It is recommended that applicants have a minimum undergraduate GPA of 3.75 and an LSAT score in the 91st percentile.

 - Describe your interest in the law as a profession.
 - Describe your two most significant extracurricular activities or honors received in college.
 - Describe your most significant leadership experience.
 - Describe your most significant employment experience.
