## **George Page Residential Complex**

Across the street from the Caruso School of Law, the George Page Apartment Complex provides quick access to classes and the Jerene Appleby Harnish Law Library. Residents also have access to a variety of residential amenities such as community rooms, fitness facilities, a large outdoor patio with BBQ grills, wireless internet, and mailboxes.

#### **Apartments**

Law students reside in apartments located in F and G blocks. Each apartment contains:

- Four single-occupancy bedrooms furnished with an extra-long full bed, dresser, nightstand, desk, and chair
- A kitchen equipped with a gas stovetop and oven, refrigerator, sink with disposal, and dishwasher
- A living room furnished with a couch, coffee table, end table, dining table, chairs, and a flat-screen television
- An apartment bathroom containing two sinks, one shower, and one toilet

#### **Athletic and Gym Facilities**

Residents have access to the gym located in the Caruso School of Law academic building. Additionally, the Pepperdine Fitness Center conveniently offers a variety of exercise equipment. Residents also have access to an Olympic-size pool, tennis courts, basketball courts, a track, a soccer field, hiking trails, and group fitness classes.

### **Shuttles**

Pepperdine operates two shuttles every 10 to 15 minutes that stop at key campus locations. During weekdays, an off-campus Malibu shopping shuttle is also available to take students to nearby grocery and shopping centers.
