GRADUATE STUDENT HOUSING

Across the street from the School of Law, the George Page Residential Complex provides quick access to classes and the Jerene Appleby Harnish Law Library. Built in 1996, the complex is organized in four blocks of apartments situated around a grassy courtyard. All residents have access to a common area that contains sofas, tables and chairs, a television, restrooms, a large patio area, and their mailboxes. Law students reside in apartments located in the recently renovated F and G blocks. Each apartment contains:

- Four single-occupancy bedrooms furnished with an extra-long full bed, dresser, nightstand, desk, and chair.
- An apartment bathroom containing two sinks, one shower, and one toilet.
- A kitchen equipped with a gas stovetop and oven, refrigerator, microwave, sink with disposal, and dishwasher.
- A living room furnished with a couch, coffee table, end table, dining table, chairs, and a flat-screen television.

ATHLETIC AND GYM FACILITIES

- The School of Law provides a gym in the academic building for students to use. Additionally, the Firestone Fieldhouse Weight Center conveniently offers a variety of exercise equipment for residents.
- Residents also have access to an Olympic-size pool, nine tennis courts, basketball courts, a track, a soccer field, and exercise classes.

SHUTTLES AND PARKING

- Pepperdine operates two shuttles that stop at key locations around the Malibu campus.
- An off-campus Malibu shopping shuttle is also available to take students to nearby shopping locations.
- Residents with parking permits may park in the two lots adjacent to the George Page Residential Complex as well as in additional lots throughout campus.
