## Cost

The payment to Pepperdine for the trip will be \$1300 per person. While traveling, the program will cover meals, flights, visas, and ground transportation. If money is something keeping you from applying for the trip, we will make available an application for scholarship to assist with the cost after all interviews take place.

You will need to pay for any medications and inoculations that will be required for travel to Uganda (this is in addition to the \$1300 payment to Pepperdine). If you have not traveled much to developing countries, you should anticipate spending a few hundred dollars for those. If selected for the program, we will go over in detail what you need to do before leaving.
