If you have a pending or secured externship, you must also attend one of the mandatory orientation meetings as well as a weekly clinical seminar, unless you have previously attended the orientation and seminar.

- Summer 2011 Externship Orientation – April 25 or April 26.
- Law firms do not qualify for externship credit.
- Externship students must enroll in both fieldwork and a clinical seminar through the Clinical Programs Office in room 331A.
- All externships must be approved in advance by Professor Serafino, Director of Clinical Programs. Students must register with the Clinical Programs Office by June 3, 2011. All clinical courses are graded High Pass/Pass/Credit/Fail.
