Cost

- *Program Cost: \$1800* (you pay the program \$1800 and we cover the following expenses: main meals, flights, hotels, visas, ground transportation, safari)
- *Expenses in addition to the \$1800 to anticipate:* Medications, inoculations, travel snacks, gifts, miscellaneous
 - ◆ Everyone will need anti-malaria medication for the trip. The inoculations you need will depend on your travel history. For more information of the required vaccinations visit the CDC website for Uganda. We recommend Hep A, Typhoid, and Yellow Fever vaccinations along with a prescription anti-malaria medication.
- *Estimated total cost (Program cost + Additional expenses): \$2000 - \$2500*
