



SPRING BREAK IN INDIA

March 11-20, 2016

What will we be doing?

During our ten-day trip in Delhi, we will be providing training to Indian lawyers through Counsel to Secure Justice, a human rights organization started by alum, Jon Derby, dedicated to fighting for stronger prosecution of sex crime. We will also be visiting other legal NGO's in the area to see how they are bringing justice to India in areas such as aiding in slum development and fighting against forced labor and sex trafficking. Our time in India might include a day trip to the Taj Mahal and a debrief retreat in the Himalayas (plans are subject to change at this point). Participation in the program will require multiple hours of preparation in advance.

Who will be there?

6-8 2L and 3L law students will be accompanied by Global Justice Manager, Jenna DeWalt and Professor Jeff Baker.

How much will it cost?

The total subsidized cost for the trip will be in the \$1500-\$1800 range paid by each student before the trip (the price depends on the number of students selected to go). The Global Justice Program will book and pay for flights, hotels, meals, and excursions.
