Our program highlights the understanding of conflict resolution from a U.S. perspective but also features presentations and faculty with an international perspective. The scholar will join in our featured alternative dispute resolution classes and also our programming in US Legal English, as well as the professional trainings. The scholar will also have access to the law school faculty and library to conduct research that is helpful to their work in their country of origin.
