### **Submission Deadlines:**

- 1-2 page article abstract is due on **October 15, 2019**
- Final papers must be submitted no later than **December 20, 2019**

### **Paper Format Requirements:**

- 12 point font, 1-inch margins, double space
- 11 point font for footnotes, extra space between footnotes
- No more than 20 pages in length, no less than 5 pages in length
- Please submit your abstract and article in PDF format

- Intersection of Dispute Resolution and Religion
- Comparative Eastern and Western Viewpoints on Arbitration, Mediation, Negotiation
- Faith-Based Dispute Resolution Practices
